Monthly Programs Report (Suzanne)

- Next event in September; In-person; Five sign-ups so far
- October event had to be changed; Total Rewards; Speaker fees; Speaker was not cooperative; Was able to find another; "Importance of Listening"; speaker is out of state; Total Rewards still wants to co-sponsor; Total Rewards wanted the price to be \$25 to \$35 for virtual (that's our in-person); Matt thinks we need to stick with our prices;
